	The doctorate intends to train scholars able to identify ample scientific problems of historical or philosophical nature; plan and carry out studies organically connected to the chosen area of research;
	identify and make competent use of necessary sources or critically analyze data, texts, themes, concepts and methods; identify and make use of an international bibliography; organize and present the material they have gathered and compose a scientific text. The program focuses on an interdisciplinary approach based on a global, diachronic and comparative perspective.
