EDUCATIONAL AIMS AND RESEARCH TOPICS: The purpose of the Clinical Epidemiology School is to form researchers in the biological and medical field able to carry out clinical trials, to validate new guidelines, to propose innovative therapeutic and diagnostic approaches. Aim of the School is also to train researchers to relieve necessity of people and to evaluate epidemiological data assessing effects on health measures of prevention.

The main research fields are the following:

- -Psycophysical and educational development from birth to adolescence and reproductive
- -Prevention of neurological disability and development disorders
- -Physiopathology of reproduction
- -Epidemiology and clinical basis of health assistance. Experimentation of protective intervention on perinatology determinants in development disorders.
- -Prevention on obstetric health and neonatology assistance.
- -Epidemiology of infancy necessity
- -Reproduction disorders and its epidemiological, clinical and molecular determinants.
- -New approaches to the diagnosis and to the treatment of inflammatory and immunological chronic diseases.
- -Prevention and obstetric health in perinatalogy with specific attention to preventive aspects and relationship between children and their parents.

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- -Neuro- and physical development.
- -Social and education issues from birth to adolescence.
- -Quality of life and treatment of patients affected by chronic disease.
- -Assessment of criticisms of health assistance, technological progress and outcome of children born from artificial fecundation.

The specificity of the Clinical Epidemiology School may be considered similar to the Residency in Pediatrics, Gynecology and Infantile Neuropsychiatry.

Research and formation activities will be held to the IRCCS Burlo Garofolo of Trieste, but also in the co-operating centers placed in the University of Turin and Brescia; in Angola and Brasil in the field of international cooperation programs. More exchange programs are active in Baltimore and Chicago.
