Call for Admission of Candidates Educated Abroad to the Ph.D. School in Physics of the University of Trieste for the Year 2008

Art. 1 Announcement

The University of Trieste announces a competition, based on academic qualifications, for 5 grants reserved for candidates educated abroad, i.e. in countries outside the Eurepean Union (EU) for admission to the Ph.D. School of Physics of the University of Trieste. Of the 5 grants:

- 3 are funded by Elettra, the national synchrotron laboratory located in Basovizza in the outskirts of Trieste, and will be assigned for study and research *on experimental synchrotron physics (see.eg.,* (http://www.elettra.trieste.it/info/index.html and/or contact fulvio.parmigiani@elettra.trieste.it , Paolucci@elettra.trieste.it);
- 1 is funded by INFN, the National Institute for Nuclear Physics, and will be assigned for study and research in *experimental or theoretical INFN* physics (see, e.g, http://www.ts.infn.it/en/physics.html and/or contact andrea.vacchi@ts.infn.it);
- 1 is funded by INAF, the National Institute for Astrophysics, and will be assigned for study and research on *Metallicity evolution in high redshift galaxies* (see e.g., http://www.ts.astro.it/astro/laricerca_prog_en.html and/or contact tozzi@oats.inaf.it).

The selection will be based on the scientific qualifications of the candidates.

An application for this competition does not prevent candidates from applying for another competition based on both academic qualifications and examinations which will be announced at http://www.univ.trieste.it/dottorati/?file=DottBandi.inc (link at *Bando Scuole e Corsi di dottorato di ricerca XXIII ciclo (II ciclo delle Scuole) e relative integrazioni*), with deadline for application in early october 2007.

The courses of the Ph.D. programme will start on January 1st, 2008.

Art. 2 Requirements

Applications are invited from candidates who:

- are citizen of a non-EU country
- are not resident in Italy;
- have obtained abroad (in a non-EU country) an academic qualification equivalent to the Italian "laurea specialistica", e.g. to a Master of Science degree, or expect to obtain this academic qualification before September 10th, 2007. This qualification must be awarded by a non-Italian institution. The equivalence of each qualification to one of the above-mentioned Italian degree will be established (for the sole purpose of this competition) by the Academic Board (Collegio Docenti) of the School.

The University may exclude candidates lacking admission requirements at any time.

Art. 3 Applications and deadline

Applications will include 1. the attached application form and 2. the documents listed below and should arrive by midnight CET (Central European Time) September 5th, 2007. Note that the date of the post mark will not guarantee acceptance.

Applications that are incomplete or that arrive after the deadline (September 5th, 2007) will not be considered.

The application form should include the following:

- personal data (name and surname, date and place of birth, place of residence, and nationality);
- contact address, e-mail address and telephone number (the candidate must immediately communicate any changes of these data);
- indication of the grants of art. 1 for which the candidate wishes to apply.
- educational qualification giving access to university education, and an indication of when and where it was obtained.
- academic qualification with final mark (if any) with an indication of when and where it was obtained, or alternatively a declaration that the candidate expects to obtain the requested academic qualification before September 10th, 2007.
- information on grants that the candidate may have been awarded by Italian, foreign or international bodies to attend a Ph.D. Degree course or to carry out study and research activities, indicating the starting date, the length, and the amount;

The following documents must be attached to the form:

- a curriculum vitae et studiorum;
- a statement of purpose
- a brief summary of the master thesis, if applicable;
- a certificate of the academic qualification, issued by the University that awarded it, if already awarded, or alternatively (see Art. 6 below) a declaration that he/she expects to obtain the requested academic qualification before September 10th, 2007. In this latter case, the awarding University and the expected date of awarding must be specified.
- the degree transcript stating the examinations taken by the candidate, with marks and a short description of their content;
- two letters of presentation by professors or experts in the field of the candidate; the letters must be sent directly by the professors or experts to *Scuola di Dottorato in Fisica*, *Dipartimento di Fisica*, *Via Valerio 2*, 34127 Trieste, *Italy* or by e-mail to *segrfisica@trieste.infn.it*;
- a report on any research carried out by the candidate (if any);
- a list of publications (if any);
- the candidates are strongly encouraged to produce as well the results of:
 - a Graduate Record Examination (GRE) Subject Test in physics (or chemistry or mathematics), and
 - either the Test of English as Foreign Language (TOEFL) or the Preliminary English Test (PET);
- any further qualification and information that should be taken into account, including a study and research programme the candidate intends to pursue;

All documents must be in Italian or English, or accompanied by a translation into Italian or English.

Within 60 days of the publication of the competition result, candidates will be able to recover, at their own expense, all the documents and qualifications they presented. After this period, the University will not be responsible for keeping the above-mentioned documents.

Art. 4 Grants – General rules

The duration of the University grants mentioned in art. 1 is three years. The grants cannot be combined with any other grant assigned by the Italian Government.

The gross amount of each study grant for the year 2008 is fixed at about € 12.250 per year, which implies a net monthly salary of about € 850. The winners of the competition may receive a contribution towards relocation costs.

The winners are exempted from paying university fees, apart from a local tax of about € 100 per year.

Art. 5 Admission

The grants mentioned in art. 1 are assigned by a Committee indicated by the Academic Board of the School and appointed by the University of Trieste, on the basis of the evaluation of the academic qualifications of each candidate.

The list of named winners and of those who may be considered as eligible if places become free, will be published on the official notice board of the Ufficio "Laureati" and on the Web site at http://www.univ.trieste.it/dottorati/ on the page Esami di ammissione – graduatorie at the link Graduatoria (Scuola di Dottorato in Fisica) by September 20th, 2007.

Any candidate named as a winner whose certificate of academic qualification has not been received will be considered to be a winner only conditionally, subject to the qualification certificate being received by October 20^{2h} 2007.

No personal communication of the competition result will be given.

Art. 6 Enrollment

The named winners must enroll, under penalty of exclusion, no later than October 25th 2007, by sending the following documents to the Università di Trieste, Ripartizione Segreterie Laureati-Segreteria Dottorati di ricerca, Piazzale Europa 1, 34127, Trieste, Italy or by fax to +390405583100:

NOTE

To perfect the enrollment the above documentation must be completed as soon as possible and anyhow within December 31:

- 1. a translation in Italian of the certificate of academic qualification approved by an Italian consular office of the country where the qualification was obtained;
- 2. a "dichiarazione di valore in loco" of the academic qualification from the same consular office;
- 3. the fiscal code;
- 4. the entry visa or the foreigners permit to stay

As it may take a fairly long time to obtain the document 1) and 2) above, the candidate are urged to appy for them promptly, at the nearest consular office, as they become named winners. In fact they are encouraged to apply for them already at the time when they submit their application to the competition.
