| Course description and objectives | <ul> <li>Scientific and educational program</li> <li>The general educational aim of the "History of Societies, Institutions and Thought.</li> <li>From Medieval to Contemporary History" doctorate is uniform for all curricula, even though differing themes and perspectives are explored depending on the specific area of interest.</li> <li>The doctorate intends to train scholars able to identify broad scientific problems of historical or philosophical nature; plan and carry out studies organically connected to the chosen area of research, identify and make competent use of necessary sources or critically analyze data, texts, themes, concepts and methods; identify and make use of an international bibliography; organize and present the material they have gathered and compose a scientific text.
