Notice opening procedure for Erasmus+ Traineeship grants 2024-2025 Second Round

The second round for applications for Erasmus+ Traineeship grants for 2024-2025 is now open, as established in the original notice.

Deadline for applications: 21st July 2025 at 12:00 (CET)

Results

The list of successful students will be published on the Official University Notice Board and on the call webpage by **4**th **August 2025**. The online publication of this list has legal value.

Grants of successful candidates will be automatically considered accepted.

Traineeship period

Traineeships can start from 15th September 2025 and must be completed by 31st July 2026.

Financial contribution

As detailed in the original notice, the University of Trieste has assessed how much funding is available for additional rounds.

Following the first round, €407,856.00 were assigned from Erasmus+ funding for 2024-2025 and ministerial funding.

With this second round, an additional €300,000.00 have been added from the same funding sources.

The total funds for Erasmus+ traineeships in 2024-2025 therefore come to €707,856.00.

Grants are subject to availability of funds. In case of insufficient financial resources, the University may establish a limit on the maximum duration of grants.

Students with grants covering a limited period may complete their traineeship in 'zero grant' mode, thus keeping their Erasmus student status till the end of their mobility period.

Eligible countries

The traineeship can be carried out in one of the countries detailed in the original notice:

- Countries participating in the Erasmus+ programme;
- Third countries associated to the programme;
- Third countries not associated to the programme.

South Africa is also included among the third countries not associated with the programme for this round.

Host institution requirements

Traineeship activities can be carried out at any company, public or private institution, with a registered office in one of the eligible countries. An Erasmus+ agreement is only required for higher education institutions in third countries not associated with the programme. For all other types of host institution, **no agreement is needed**.

For higher education institutions in third countries not associated with the programme, there must be an active Erasmus+ inter-institutional agreement between UniTS and the host structure.

Please note: before applying to a higher education institution in one of these countries, please contact the International Mobility Office to verify whether there is an existing agreement. If there is no existing agreement, your application will not be considered.
