Italian Presidential Decree No 445 of 28
December 2000

Article 47 (amended)

Self-drafted affidavit

1. The affidavit concerning statuses, personal qualities or facts that are within the direct knowledge of the individual concerned shall be replaced by a declaration made and signed by that same individual in accordance with the procedures laid down in Article 38.
2. The declaration made in the declarant's own interest may also relate to statuses, personal qualities and facts concerning other individuals of whom they have direct knowledge.
3. Without prejudice to the exceptions expressly provided for by law, when dealing with public administrations and public service providers, all statuses, personal qualities and facts not expressly indicated in Article 46 shall be proved by the individual concerned by means of a self-drafted affidavit.
4. Except where the law expressly provides that reporting to the Judicial Police is a necessary prerequisite for issuing a duplicate of documents attesting to an individual's identity or to their personal status and qualities, the loss of such documents be proved by the person requesting the duplicate by means of a self-declaration.
