























→ PODCASTS

T4EU Chairs Małgorzata Poks, PhD, DLitt (USil) and Martina Paradiz, PhD (UP) delivered lectures and led discussions at Sofia University on topics ranging from climate change, sustainability, and biosemiotics to Al in research and language learning. They also participated in key events and conferences addressing global challenges and the role of universities, presenting research on climate education, intercultural learning, and Al bias in line with EEA and EU goals. Bringle, the sessions explored civic engagement in higher education and the integration of Service-Learning into curriculum and teaching practice.

→ T4EU STUDENTS AT THE EUROPEAN STUDENT ASSEMBLY

On 26–28 May 2025, T4EU students joined peers from across Europe at the European Student Assembly in Strasbourg to debate key EU challenges and shape policy proposals. Actively involved in five of eight panels, T4EU students contributed to discussions on mental health, AI and democracy, lifelong learning, housing, and cultural inclusion, helping draft 74 adopted recommendations and showcasing the Alliance's commitment to civic engagement and innovation. On 3 June 2025, an online workshop <u>I'll Do It Tomorrow: The Psychology of Procrastination</u>, organised by the University of Primorska, focused on understanding procrastination, its connection to stress, and the role of mindfulness in overcoming it. Participants learned practical strategies to boost focus and build healthier study habits through mindful techniques.

→ INTERNATIONAL SCIENTIFIC CONFERENCE

The University of Silesia in Katowice organised an international scientific conference entitled 'Industrial Heritage and the Traces of Industrialization in Urban Space'; the event took place on 6 May 2025 in Katowice. It was devoted to multifaceted reflection on the industrial heritage and traces of industrialisation in contemporary urban spaces.





→ T4EU REPRESENTATIVES IN PARIS

Transform4Europe took part in the 'Choose Europe for Science' event in Paris, hosted by French President Emmanuel Macron to advance European higher education and research collaboration. T4EU's delegation, including Prof. Dominik Brodowski, Klavdija Kutnar, Prof. Tomasz Pietrzykowski, and Agnieszka Turska-Kawa, joined European leaders and academics in supporting this initiative. → SEMINAR: 'UPDATING UNIVERSITY LEADERSHIP...'

On 2-3 June, Universidade Católica Portuguesa oranised the seminar '<u>Updating University Leadership to Address New Societal Challenges</u>'. The programme included a combination of online sessions and four in-person seminars held at different universities, with the following topics: Responsible Leadership, Global Leadership, Leadership in Al-Driven Environments and Sustainable Leadership. taking place on 2 and 3 June.

→ PROF. VESSELIN POPOVSKI VISITS THE USIL

In April 2025, Prof. Vesselin Popovski from Soka University in Japan was a guest of the University of Silesia in Katowice and delivered a lecture entitled 'The Second Charter: Reimagining the UN'. Sofia University St. Kliment Ohridski hosted the Annual T4EU PhD Conference 'Societies on the Move: Challenges of Today, Prospects for the Future' on 1–2 April 2025. The conference gathered together around 60 participants, most of whom are PhD students from T4EU Alliance partners. The keynote speeches were connected to researchers' personal branding, specifics of defending PhD dissertations around the world, populism and contemporary societal challenges.

→ T-LAB AND STAKEHOLDER CHALLENGE

On 2-4 June 2025, the <u>First T-Lab Fair & Second Stakeholder Challenge</u>, organised by T4EU, was officially launched at the Rectorate Building of Sofia University St. Kliment Ohridski. This initiative, part of the T4EU Environmental Transformation Lab 'Smart cities and regions', aimed at engaging young researchers and graduate students in the Alliance's outreach, stimulating interdisciplinary research, and fostering collaboration with key stakeholders.

→ 5TH T4EU SCIENCE CAFÉ

On 14 May 2025, the 5th T4EU Science Café took place during Universidade Católica Portuguesa's Innovation Day, highlighting how universities can drive innovation through collaboration with industry. Discussions focused on the challenges and opportunities of applying scientific research to real-world solutions, including examples in circular economy and sustainable technology.

→ MATCHMAKING EVENT FOR JOINT STUDIES

The <u>Matchmaking Event for Joint Studies</u>, hosted by Jean Monnet University, was held on 31 March and 1 April 2025; it brought together vice-presidents, rectors, programme coordinators, and academic staff from 10 universities across Europe for two dynamic days of discussion, collaboration, and innovation.

A seminar entitled 'Global Academic Leadership' was held at the University of Silesia on 3 April 2025 as part of the Academy for Professional Excellence initiative of the Transform4Europe project. The meeting explored global challenges in academic
